EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (HEALTH OF AQUACULTURE ANIMALS AND PRODUCTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

- I, SIMON COVENEY, Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), for the purpose of giving effect to Commission Implementing Directive 2012/31/EU of 25 October 2012¹, hereby make the following regulations:
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Health of Aquaculture Animals and Products) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.
- 2. The European Communities (Health of Aquaculture Animals and Products) Regulations 2008 (S.I. No. 261 of 2008) are amended by substituting in Regulation 2(1), for the definition of "Council Directive" the following—
 - " 'Council Directive' means Council Directive No. 2006/88/EC of 24 October 2006², as amended by Commission Directive No. 2008/53/EC of 30 April 2008³ and Commission Implementing Directive 2012/31/EU of 25 October 2012;".
