RULES OF THE SUPERIOR COURTS (JUDICIAL REVIEW) 2018

1. (1) These Rules, which may be cited as the Rules of the Superior Courts (Judicial Review) 2018, shall come into operation on the 2nd day of September 2018.

(2) These Rules shall be construed together with the Rules of the Superior Courts.

(3) The Rules of the Superior Courts as amended by these Rules may be cited as the Rules of the Superior Courts 1986 to 2018.

2. Appendix T to the Rules of the Superior Courts is amended by the substitution therein for Form 14 of the form set out in the Schedule.
