- I, DERMOT AHERN, Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 5 of the Criminal Justice (Forensic Evidence) Act 1990 (No. 34 of 1990), hereby make the following Regulations:
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Forensic Evidence) Act 1990 (Amendment) Regulations 2008.
- 2. In these Regulations "1992 Regulations" means Criminal Justice (Forensic Evidence) Act 1990 Regulations 1992 (S.I. No. 130 of 1992).
 - 3. The 1992 Regulations are amended as follows:
 - (a) by the substitution of Appendix A to these Regulations for Appendix A to the 1992 Regulations;
 - (b) by the substitution of Appendix B to these Regulations for Appendix B to the 1992 Regulations;
 - (c) by the substitution of Appendix C to these Regulations for Appendix C to the 1992 Regulations.


