- (2) These Rules shall be construed together with the District Court Rules 1997 (S.I. No. 93 of 1997) and all other District Court Rules.
- (3) The District Court Rules as amended by these Rules may be cited as the District Court Rules 1997 to 2016.
- 2. The District Court Rules are amended by the substitution of the form in Schedule 1 for the form bearing the like number in the Schedule B annexed to the District Court Rules 1997.
