ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ACT 1992
(FLUORINATED GREENHOUSE GAS) REGULATIONS 2011

I, PHIL HOGAN, Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 6 and 53 of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 (No. 7 of 1992), hereby make the following Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Protection Agency Act (Fluorinated Greenhouse Gas) Regulations 2011.

Entry into Force

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 20 June 2011.

Interpretation

3. In these Regulations—

“Agency” means the Environmental Protection Agency.

Purpose

4. (1) The purpose of these Regulations is to designate the Agency as the Competent Authority for the implementation of:

Commission Regulation (EC) No 842/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 May 2006 on certain fluorinated greenhouse gases;

Commission Regulation (EC) No 1493/2007 of 17 December 2007 establishing, pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 842/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the format for the report to be submitted by producers, importers and exporters of certain fluorinated greenhouse gases;

Commission Regulation (EC) No 1494/2007 of 17 December 2007 establishing, pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 842/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the form of labels and additional labelling requirements as regards products and equipment containing certain fluorinated greenhouse gases;

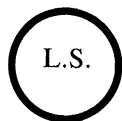
