- I, BARRY ANDREWS, Minister of State at the Department of Health and Children, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 150 of the Adoption Act 2010 (No. 21 of 2010) and the Health and Children (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2010 (S.I. No. 508 of 2010), hereby make the following regulations:
- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Adoption Act 2010 (Pre-Placement Consultation Procedure) Regulations 2010.
 - 2. These regulations come into operation on 3 November 2010.
- 3. Each of the forms set out in the Schedule shall be used in the case and manner indicated in the form.

These regulations set out the forms prescribed by section 17 of the Adoption Act 2010 (No. 21 of 2010) which are to be used in circumstances where an adoption placement is deferred for the purposes of allowing the father or guardian of a child make an application to court under section 6A or section 11(4) of the Guardianship of Infants Act 1964 (as inserted by the Status of Children Act 1987).
