FOOD HYGIENE (REVOCATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS) REGULATIONS 2017

- I, CATHERINE BYRNE, Minister of State at the Department of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 5 and 54 (inserted by section 25 of the Irish Medicines Board (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2006 (No. 3 of 2006)) of the Health Act 1947 (No. 28 of 1947) (as adapted by the Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2017 (S.I. No. 364 of 2017) and the Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 455 of 2011)) and the Health (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) (No. 4) Order 2017 (S.I. No. 339 of 2017), after consultation with the Minister for Business, Enterprise and Innovation and the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine, hereby make the following regulations:
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food Hygiene (Revocation of Certain Provisions) Regulations 2017.
- 2. Paragraphs (21) and (22) of Regulation 25 of the Food Hygiene Regulations (S.I. No. 205 of 1950) are revoked.
