# SUPREME COURT, COURT OF APPEAL AND HIGH COURT (FEES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019

- I, CHARLES FLANAGAN, Minister for Justice and Equality, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 65 (as amended by section 66 of the Civil Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2011 (No. 23 of 2011)) of the Courts of Justice Act 1936 (No. 48 of 1936) (as adapted by the Justice and Law Reform (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 138 of 2011)), with the consent of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, hereby order as follows:
- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court, Court of Appeal and High Court (Fees) (Amendment) Order 2019.
  - (2) This Order comes into operation on 25 October 2019.
- 2. The Supreme Court, Court of Appeal and High Court (Fees) Order 2014 (S.I. No. 492 of 2014) is amended in Schedule 1 -

  - (b) by the substitution of the following for Part 6:
